Description of Activities:

Internship Program –

KLKK, KSMA, KCHA, KCHA-AM, KCZE annually conducts an on-going internship program to give high school and college students a hands-on experience in radio broadcasting. The stations invited students to apply for the various internship opportunities through recruitment at the local high school guidance offices and speech coaches, and by contacting the internship coordinators.

During the reporting period covering the Period from October 1, 2008 to September 30, 2009, five (5) high school students participated in the stations training program.

School Career Fairs/Events –

KLKK, KSMA, KCHA, KCHA-AM, KCZE annually contacts area schools and offers to participate in any school career fairs and events that may be scheduled. Various employees participate in the events, depending on the specialty the students are most interested in.

J Brooks conducted several programs at area schools covering the Period from October 1, 2008 to September 30, 2009.

Iowa Broadcasters Scholarship Program –

All stations in the employment group participate in the IBA Scholarship program, which awards scholarships to deserving high school seniors who study broadcasting during their college careers. Each station airs public service announcements promoting the application availability at the station office.
